ORDER

(Passed on this the 23rd day of October 2009)

This case relates to the extension of the validity of the existing Scale of Rates of the Chennai Port Trust (CHPT).

2. The existing Scale of Rates (SOR) of the CHPT was last approved by this Authority vide Order No. TAMP/36/2005-CHPT dated 7 March 2006. The Order prescribed the validity of the SOR till 31 March 2008. Subsequently, the validity of the SOR was extended by this Authority till 30 September 2009 vide Order dated 17 June 2009, which is notified in the Gazette of India on 20 June 2009 vide Gazette no. 106. The CHPT vide its letter dated 29 September 2009 has requested to extend the validity of the existing Scale of Rates for further period from 1 October 2009.

3. The CHPT has filed its proposal for revision of its SOR. Additional information/clarifications requested on various points emerging from the proposal are furnished recently by the port which is under scrutiny. It may take some more time for the case to mature for final consideration of this Authority.

4. Since the validity of the existing SOR has expired on 30 September 2009 and recognising the time required for finalising the case this Authority extends the validity of the existing SOR of the CHPT till 31 March 2010 or till the effective date of implementation of the revised Scale of Rates, whichever is earlier.

5. Additional surplus, if any, over and above the admissible cost and permissible return for the period post 1 April 2008 will be adjusted fully in the tariff to be determined.
