ORDER

(Passed on this 17th day of June 2009)

This case relates to the extension of the validity of the interim tariff arrangement approved by the Authority for the operations of the Chennai International Terminals Private Ltd. (CITPL) at the Chennai Port Trust.

2. The interim tariff arrangement approved by the Authority vide Order No. TAMP/10/2009-CITPL dated 15 May 2009 for operations of the CITPL is valid till 30 June 2009. This Order is notified in the Gazette of India on 29 May 2009 vide Gazette no. 85.

3. The proposal filed by the operator for fixation of its tariff is taken on consultation. The operator has furnished the additional information / clarifications requested on various points emerging from the proposal. It may, however, take some more time for analysis and for final consideration of the Authority.

4. Since the validity of the existing tariff arrangement is to expire on 30 June 2009, this Authority extends the validity the existing tariff arrangement till 30 September 2009 or final disposal of the tariff proposal filed by CITPL, whichever is earlier.

5. Additional surplus, if any, over and above the admissible cost and permissible return earned by the CITPL from the date of commencement of operations will be fully adjusted in the tariff to be determined.
