ORDER

(Passed on this the 31st day of March 2010)

This case relates to extension of the existing tariff at the liquid cargo jetty operated by the Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited (BPCL) at the Jawaharlal Nehru Port Trust (JNPT).

2. The existing tariff at the said liquid cargo jetty was approved by this Authority vide Order dated 7 August 2007 and the validity of the tariff was prescribed till 31 March 2010.

3. The BPCL has filed proposal for revision of its tariff which is taken on consultation. The proposal is also internally scrutinized and additional / clarifications sought requested from the operator is awaited. In the meanwhile, the BPCL vide its letter dated 23 March 2010 has requested to extend the validity of the existing SOR.

4. As mentioned above, the additional information / clarifications sought from the operator is awaited. Further, joint hearing as part of consultation process is to be set up. It will, therefore, take time for approval of the revised tariff.

5. In view of the above, this Authority extends the validity of the existing tariff till 30 September 2010 or till effective date of implementation of the revised tariff, whichever is earlier.

6. Additional surplus, if any, over and above the admissible cost and permissible return for the period post 1 April 2010 will be adjusted fully in the tariff to be determined.
