This case relates to extension of the validity of the existing tariff for the services rendered by the TM International Logistics Limited (TMILL) at berth no. 12 in the Kolkata Port Trust (KOPT).

2. The validity of the existing tariff approved by this Authority vide Order No.TAMP/49/2005 – TMILL dated 12 October 2007 for the services rendered by the TM International Logistics Limited at the said berth is prescribed till 31 March 2010.

3. The TMILL has filed its proposal revision of the SOR which is taken on consultation with the concerned users.

4. In the meanwhile the TMILL, vide letter dated 16 March 2010, has, inter alia, requested to extend the validity of the existing tariff.

5. Since it will take time for the proposal to mature for final consideration of this Authority and recognizing that the validity of the existing SOR expires on 31 March 2010 it is necessary to extend the validity of the existing SOR beyond 31 March 2010. Therefore, this Authority extends the validity of the existing SOR of TMILL till 30 September 2010 or till effective date of implementation of the revised SOR, whichever is earlier.

6. Additional surplus, if any, over and above the admissible cost and permissible return for the period post 1 April 2010 will be adjusted fully in the tariff to be determined.
