**ORDER**

(Passed on this 31<sup>st</sup> day of March 2010)

This case relates to extension of the existing Scale of Rates (SOR) of South West Port Limited (SWPL) for the multipurpose bulk cargo terminal at berth nos. 5A and 6A in the Mormugao Port Trust.

2. The existing SOR for the said multipurpose cargo terminal was last approved by this Authority vide Order dated 29 December 2006 and the validity of the SOR was prescribed till 31 March 2010.

3. The proposal dated 16 February 2010 filed by the SWPL for revision of its SOR along with the draft SOR furnished on 19 March 2010 has been registered as tariff case and is taken on consultation. The SWPL, vide letter dated 18 March 2010, has requested to extend the validity of the exiting SOR for a period of further six months.

4. The proposal filed by the SWPL will take time for internal examination. As the validity of the SOR expires on 31 March 2010 it is necessary to extend the validity beyond 31 March 2010. This Authority, therefore, extends the validity of the existing tariff till 30 September 2010 or till effective date of implementation of the revised tariff, whichever is earlier.

5. Additional surplus, if any, over and above the admissible cost and permissible return for the period post 1 April 2010 will be adjusted fully in the tariff to be determined.
