ORDER
(Passed on this 2nd day of May 2011)

This case relates to extension of the existing Scale of Rates (SOR) of the Mumbai Port Trust (MBPT).

2. This Authority vide its Order No. TAMP/57/2005-MBPT dated 28 September 2006 had notified the existing SOR of MBPT with a validity period till 31 March 2009. The validity of the existing SOR was last extended till 30 September 2010 vide Order dated 31 March 2010.

3. The proposal filed by the MBPT for revision of its SOR in October 2009 is registered as tariff case and taken on consultation. Joint hearing in the case was held on 18 January 2011. As agreed at the joint hearing the MBPT has filed revised proposal only on 11 April 2011 and furnished the additional information/clarification sought vide letter dated 11 November 2010. The revised proposal filed by the MBPT has been circulated to the concerned user / user association for comments.

4. Recognizing the time required for further processing the case including scrutiny of the revised proposal recently filed by the Port and the comments, if any, to be received from the users, this Authority extends the validity of existing Scale of Rates of MBPT from the date of its expiry till 30 September 2011 or till the effective date of implementation of the Order to be passed in the proposal filed by the MBPT, whichever is earlier.

5. If any surplus over and above the admissible cost and permissible return emerges for the period post 1 April 2009, during the review of its performance, such surplus will be set off fully in the tariff to be determined.
