ORDER

(Passed on this 22nd day of July 2005)

This case relates to a proposal received from the New Mangalore Port Trust (NMPT) for approval of additional charges towards dust suppression for handling iron ore fine.

2.1. The proposal received from the NMPT was registered as a tariff case and processed following the usual consultation process adopted.

2.2. The comments received from the user organisations were also forwarded to the NMPT for feedback information. The NMPT has not furnished any response in this regard.

3.1. When this case was to be taken up for the joint hearing, the NMPT decided to withdraw its proposal and to include it in the general revision proposal to be filed shortly.

3.2. Subsequently, the NMPT had filed a proposal for general revision of its Scale of Rates. The NMPT is advised to recast its proposal since it was not found to be in line with the tariff guidelines. In its general revision proposal the NMPT has included a new tariff item for water sprinkling and dosing charges for handling coal and ores.

4. Since this proposal forms a part of general revision proposal, it is not found necessary to process this case separately.

5. In the result, and for the reasons given above, and based on a collective application of mind, this Authority decides to close this case as withdrawn.
