ORDER

(Passed on this 28th day of March 2007)

This case relates to the extension of the validity of the existing Scale of Rates of the Visakha Container Terminal Private Limited (VCTPL) for its operation at the Visakhapatnam Port Trust (VPT).

2. The existing Scale of Rates (SOR) of the VCTPL was approved by this Authority vide Order No. TAMP/31/2005 – VCTPL dated 30 August 2005, which was published in the Gazette of India on 19 September 2005 vide Gazette No. 134. As per the said Order, the existing SOR is valid till 31 March 2007.

3. The VCTPL has filed a proposal for revision of its SOR on 28 February 2007. The proposal is registered as a 'tariff case' and the usual consultation process has been initiated.

4. As stated earlier, the validity of the existing SOR of the VCTPL will expire on 31 March 2007. Since the proposal of the VCTPL for revision of its SOR is still in the consultative stage, and scrutiny and analysis of the proposal will involve additional time, this Authority extends the validity of the existing Scale of Rates of the VCTPL for a further period of three months till 30 June 2007 or till final disposal of the proposal filed by VCTPL, whichever is earlier.
