CORRIGENDUM

This Authority had passed an Order on 5 October 2002 in case No. TAMP/39/2002-CHPT relating to the general revision of the Scale of Rates of the Chennai Port Trust (CHPT). This Order and the (revised) Scale of Rates of the CHPT were notified in the Gazette of India Extraordinary (Part III Section 4) on 9 October 2002 vide Gazette No.229.

2. It has been noticed that some genuine mistakes have occurred in the English version of the Scale of Rates notified on 9 October 2002. The details of the corrections to be made are given below:
