ORDER

(Passed on this 31st day of March 2010)

This case relates to the extension of the validity of the existing Scale of Rates of the Tuticorin Port Trust (TPT).

2. The existing Scale of Rates (SOR) of the TPT was last approved by this Authority vide Order No. TAMP/15/2006-TPT dated 14 July 2008. The Order prescribed the validity of the SOR till 31 March 2010.

3. The comprehensive proposal filed by the TPT for general revision of its Scale of Rates, vide its letter dated 18 March 2010, is being processed for registration as a tariff case. It has also simultaneously requested to extend the validity of the existing SOR beyond 31 March 2010.

4. As the validity of the existing SOR will expire on 31 March 2010 and as the proposal filed by the port is being taken on consultation it is necessary to extend the validity of the existing SOR. In view of that this Authority extends the validity till of the existing SOR of the TPT till 30 September 2010 or till the effective date of implementation of the revised Scale of Rates, whichever is earlier.

5. If any additional surplus over and above the admissible cost and permissible return emerges for the period post 1 April 2010, during the review of its performance, such additional surplus will be set off fully in the tariff to be determined.
