

The Activities of the Tariff Authority for Major Ports  
In the year 2015-16

**TARIFF AUTHORITY FOR MAJOR PORTS**

The Tariff Authority for Major Ports (TAMP) regulates the tariff of Major Port Trusts and BOT Terminals operating thereat. TAMP is an ISO 9001:2008 compliant organization for Quality Management System. It is also ISO 27001:2013 certified organization for Information Security Management System.

2. The Board of TAMP met seven times in the year 2015-16 and also had four Special Meetings that year. The Board decided 47 tariff cases of various Ports including six cases of Estate related charges, surpassing the overall target of 35 tariff cases set by itself for the year 2015-16.

3. As a part of consultation process in regulating tariff, TAMP organized 33 Hearings jointly with the Ports, Port users, BOT operators and prospective bidders for Port tariff and for PPP Projects. The joint hearings gave an opportunity to the stakeholders of being heard of their views on the proposals. The discussions at the joint hearing very often throw up issues that call for further attention by the Port Trusts / BOT operators. In some cases, based on the discussions, as directed by the TAMP, the Port Trusts modified and fine tuned their proposals.

4.1. Following mass movement of “Swachh Bharat”, TAMP undertakes cleanliness activity on regular basis. A special cleanliness drive was carried out on 02-10-2015, on the eve of Birthday of Father of the Nation, Mahatma Gandhi.

4.2. In connection with the celebrations of 125<sup>th</sup> Berth Anniversary of Bharat Ratna Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, the 26<sup>th</sup> November 2015 was observed as Constitution Day.
