ORDER

(Passed on this 11th day of May 2006)

This case related to extension of the validity of the existing Scale of Rates of the Chennai Container Terminal Limited (CCTL) prescribed vide Order dated 4 May 2004 passed in Case No.TAMP/82/2003-CCTL.

2. The Scale of Rates of CCTL prescribed vide this Authority's Order dated 4 May 2004, was notified in the Gazette of India on 21 May 2004 and came into force from 5 June 2004 after expiry of 15 days from the date of notification. The validity of the revised Scale of Rates was ordered for 2 years after which the approval accorded to it will automatically lapse unless specifically extended by this Authority as prescribed in Order dated 4 May 2004.

3. The CCTL has filed its proposal dated 18 April 2006 before this Authority for general revision of its Scale of Rates which has been taken on consultation. The consultation process initiated will take some more time to complete and in view of further actions pending in this case, disposal of the proposal filed by the CCTL will take time. The validity of the Scale of Rates of CCTL is, therefore, to be extended beyond 4 June 2006.

4. In the result, and based on the collective application of mind, this Authority extends the validity of the existing Scale of Rates of CCTL for a period of six months beyond 4 June 2006 or the effective date of implementation of the Order to be passed by this Authority on the proposal filed by the CCTL for general revision of its Scale of Rates, whichever is earlier.
