CORRIGENDUM

Mumbai, the 22nd October 2003

This Authority had passed an Order on 17 March 2003 in case No. TAMP/104/2001-VPT relating to the amendments/modification proposed by the Visakhapatnam Port Trust (VPT). This Order and was notified in the Gazette of India Extraordinary (Part III Section 4) on 3 May 2003 vide Gazette No.66.

2. It has been noticed that some genuine mistakes have occurred in the Order notified on 3 May 2003. The details of the corrections to be made are given below:
